5. PARENT - TEACHER ASSOCIATION:

According to the directives issued by the Education Department (Govt. of Maharashtra), the parent of each and every student of the Primary section is required to be a member of the Parent-Teacher Association. 6. BOOKS AND NOTE-BOOKS:

For the convenience of the parents, the books and notebooks will be available in Maharashtra Vaastu Bhandar in the school premises. In the month of May, the dates and time will be communicated to the parents on the class WhatsApp group and school website.

7. SCHOOL BUS SERVICE:

The well-being and safety of your child is not only your responsibility, but also ours. The facility of bus service is our way of showing concern towards your child's safety. For the convenience, safety and comfort of the students, the school highly recommends the use of the bus facility provided by our institution.

We request you to send your child by the school bus and extend your co-operation.

I) Highlights of our Bus Service:

- Buses are equipped with **GPS** tracking System so that the parents will be able to track the school bus by receiving SMS.
- For the safety and security of your ward the school buses are equipped with camera.
- The school buses are facilitated by lady conductors and well experienced drivers.
- All the above services are provided at a very reasonable rate.
- The bus fees is not same for all the students. It is charged according to the distance (Kilometer wise).

II) Important Instructions:

- 1) The school's bus facility is exclusively available to the students whose parents have paid the bus fees in accordance with the school's bus fees policy.
- 2) Any damage incurred will result in financial liability.
- 3) Misbehavior in the bus will result in suspension of bus services for the concerned student.
- 4) The school reserves the right to stop bus services for students who fail to adhere to the bus rules and regulations.

**** Parents should choose a fixed bus stop for their children and avoid frequent changes.**

III) Code of conduct in the bus.

- 1) Reach the bus stop at least 5 to 10 minutes before the scheduled time.
- 2) Avoid playing or running near the bus stop.
- 3) Board and exit the bus in a queue when the attendant signals you.
- 4) Speak softly and avoid loud conversations.
- 5) Avoid putting hand or head out of the bus windows.

- 6) Be kind and respectful to the other fellow students in the bus.
- 7) Listen and follow to the given instructions at all times.
- 8) Students are strictly prohibited from throwing anything from the bus window.
- 9) Students should not speak or interact with the people on the road.
- 10) Avoid eating in the bus.
