- School buses are facilitated by lady conductors and well experienced drivers.
- All the above services are provided at a very reasonable rate.
- The bus fees is not same for all the students. It is charged according to the distance (Kilometer wise).

II) Important Instructions:

- 1) The school's bus facility is exclusively available to the students whose parents have paid the bus fees in accordance with the school's bus fees policy.
- 2) Any damage incurred will result in financial liability.
- 3) Misbehavior in the bus will result in suspension of bus services for the concerned student.

- 4) Speak softly and avoid loud conversations.
- 5) Avoid putting hands out of the bus windows.
- 6) Be kind and respectful to the other fellow students in the bus.
- 7) Listen and follow to the given instructions at all times.
- 8) Students are strictly prohibited from throwing anything from the bus window.
- 9) Students should not speak or interact with the people on the road.
- 10) Avoid eating in the bus.
