5. PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION:

According to the directives issued by the Education Department (Government of Maharashtra), parent of each and every student of the Secondary section is required to be a member of the Parent-Teacher Association. The membership fee to be paid by the parent as prescribed by Government is Rs. 50/- per year, which is already included in the fee structure.

6 BOOKS AND NOTE-BOOKS :

7. SCHOOL UNIFORM AND SPORTS UNIFORM :

The regular brown school uniform and the sports uniform is compulsory for all students from the first day of the school.

A) Regular Uniform :

For Girls : I) Brown pinafore with cream shirt, black cycling shorts, maroon tie, maroon belt and black ribbon / black hair band.

II) Black Shoes - Brand-Venus (Ankle)
White Cotton socks - Brand-Pareek

For Boys : I) Cream shirt and brown half pant. **Full pant from STD VIII onwards** and plain black belt.

II) Black Shoes - Brand-Venus (Derby)
White Cotton socks - Brand-Pareek

B) Sports Uniform (for boys and girls) : To be worn on Every Thursday (Mass P.T)

I) Navy blue track pant with House color T-shirt.

II) White Canvas Shoes - Brand-Venus, White Cotton socks - Brand-Pareek

8. SCHOOL BUS SERVICE :

A) Highlights of our Bus service :

1. Buses are equipped with GPS tracking System wherein the parents will be able to track the school bus by receiving SMS.
2. For the safety and security of your ward the school buses are equipped with Camera.
3. School Buses are facilitated by lady conductors and well experienced drivers.
4. All the above services are provided at a very reasonable rate.
5. The Bus fees are not uniform for all students. The Bus fees may vary according to the distance (km wise).

B) Important Instructions:

- 1) The school's bus facility is exclusively available to the students whose parents have paid the bus fees in accordance with the school's bus fees policy.
- 2) Any damage incurred will result in financial liability.
- 3) Misbehavior on the bus will result in suspension of bus services for the concerned student.
- 4) The school reserves the right to stop bus services for students who fail to adhere to the bus rules regulations.

C) Certain code of conduct in the bus.

- 1) Reach the bus stop at least 5 to 10 minutes before the scheduled time.
- 2) Avoid playing or running near the bus stop.
- 3) Board & exit the bus when the attendant signals you.
- 4) Speak softly & avoid loud conversations.
- 5) Avoid putting hands out of the bus windows.
- 6) Be kind & respectful to the other fellow students in the bus.
- 7) Listen & follow instructions at all times.
- 8) Students are strictly prohibited from throwing anything from the bus window.
- 9) Student should not speak or interact with the people on the road.
- 10) Avoid eating in the bus.
